The Peabody Housing Authority is accepting applications for a full-time, 40 hour per week, maintenance mechanic. Applicants must be able to perform a wide range of exterior/interior maintenance of property, including minor electrical, carpentry, painting, plumbing, grounds maintenance, snow and ice duties and custodial duties. Preference will be afforded to candidates with working knowledge of Plumbing, HVAC and/or Electrical. Must have experience using power and hand tools, be able to climb ladders and lift moderate to heavy items. Applicants must be available to provide on-call nights and weekend coverage for maintenance emergencies on a rotating basis.

Applicants must have a high school diploma or G.E.D. certificate and be in good general health, possess a valid Massachusetts driver's license, and satisfactorily pass a wellness physical (including drug/alcohol screening). Applicants must pass a CORI (Criminal Offender Record Information) screening prior to employment.

Salary is \$39.27 per hour.
